

UFO AND UAP OBSERVATIONS (pp. 2–12)

On 20 September 2024 at Friesenheim-Oberweier, a woman employed by the police heard a sound like “a metal chain being dragged across the tarmac” and saw above her “an apparition in form of a wave” with a vertical colon in front. Her husband, who was in the house, saw nothing but heard a noise “like many pearls hitting on tiles”. GEP member Josef Garcia, who lives nearby, was indoors and heard nothing. However, his passive radar station confirmed the eyewitness account by date, duration (a few seconds only) and form. No plane was in the sky at the time, early at 5:34 a.m. The observation is classed as GOOD UFO.

Another long section deals with a close encounter reported by a Munich man. After the sighting of a light (dealt with in the next paragraph) he had the feeling that energy was drained from him, he heard an enormous rush in his ears, and he also felt a presence in his sleeping room. The same phenomena repeated on the two following nights. On the third night he opened his eyes and saw classic grey creatures, 5 ft. in height, standing at his bed. Also, his window which he had closed stood wide open. A few weeks later, he received a visit by two men wearing leather jackets and white shirts who wanted to extract his DNA. The whole incidents were only reported to the GEP in November 2024. As sleep paralysis coupled with sleepwalking is very unlikely and as the MIB cannot be conventionally explained, the case is classed as “unsolved”.

This is different with two conventional observations which the witness also reported as having taken place immediately before his close encounters. With several others, on 10 June 2017, he saw and photographed several UFOs. His UFOs, however, are a plane, a con trail and smudges on a window pane. His second report, also on the same day, describes a 100 m diameter black ring-like object hovering right over Munich. If this had been real, due to its large size it should have been spotted by other witnesses, too.
