

The Llanilar Recovery: New Information on this 40 year old Mystery (pp. 162–173)

According to the *Sunday Express*, 23 January 1983, Welsh farmer Irwel Evans was stunned to discover strange metallic debris covering all four fields of his property one afternoon, around the 9th of January. UFO investigator Lee Nicholson bought a sample of this debris from Philip Mantle, while archive research found that a US fighter F-111E had lost its horizontal tail plane on the very same day while flying over the site. Specifications of this right stabilizer match the recovered pieces in structure and composition.

Pelacaras / Facepeelers in Peru and Brazil: Aliens or Criminals? (pp. 173–181)

The author reports on encounters with strange beings in Peru, looking like humans, dressed in black or silver, which descend from above to narcotize people and peel away their facial skin, as has been reported in the last few years in the Amazon parts of Peru. He compares them to similar tales from Brazil, as well as beings from Peruvian history, like demons from Moche pottery. He concludes that the stories are more likely to refer to human agents than aliens, and that old mythological ideas are connected to them.

Brief notes (pp. 181–185)

Pilots observe unusual flying object near Munich – In July 2024, two pilots of a passenger plane on flight from Turkey to England spotted, and filmed, for some 15 minutes, a strange light to their right. The images show conventional aircraft lights, and these have been identified as being that of flight EXS77GS, on 2 July. However, the original investigators of the sighting won't reveal the exact date and flight number of the report, so we regrettably have insufficient data.

Kecksburg 1965 – Military Secret, not UFO? – The Kecksburg crash of 9 December 1965 is generally perceived as a UFO crash, however, its description fits a GE Mark 2-Reentry Vehicle far better, as John Ventre (MUFON) and Owen Eichler (one of the witnesses) observe.
