

UFO/UAP Observations (pp. 34–39)

Starting in 1996, a man in Halle an der Saale had several strange encounters, among them a CE IV where greys visited him in his bed and carried him through the window. He awoke in a metallic, illuminated room where the aliens manipulated him. When he again awoke in his bed, two hours had passed instead of the five minutes he had expected. The experience is explained as an instance of sleep paralysis with a following dream.

Another witness had many sightings of UFOs and orbs over Delmenhorst on a foggy day in November 2024 and on several later occasions – he explained he had filmed many yet did not sent in any footage. The case is classed as one with insufficient information.

Additional Reports (pp. 40–43)

On 28 February 2026, at Oldenburg in Holstein, a female witness filmed three lights. A check on air traffic showed an ATR-72-600 at the indicated place, and the layout of the lights on the plane and on the UFO is identical.

On 28 January 2026, a witness on a motorway near Lüdersdorf saw three motionless lights, but a check on air traffic showed a Diamond DA42 at the exact site, a schooling plane training starts. The plane has three lights in a row at the front.

A photo taken on 1 July 2025 over Ochsenhausen shows rods, an insect in flight. The illusion is created by car lights and time-exposure due to the photo having been taken in the dark.

New Evaluation of Passive Radar Case Friesenheim (pp. 43–45)

Among the explanations that had been suggested by experts for the Friesenheim radar trace was a meteor cloud, a cloud which consists of minute particles that become detached from a meteorite when it enters the atmosphere. French researcher Roche Harvé has captured similar traces. A new case of a bolide on 8 March 2026 resulted in a visible cloud which is almost a perfect match to the passive radar trace, so the GEP is now classing this observation nit as GOOD UFO but as an IFO.

X factor UAP Witness: A Methodological Approach for Generating Reliable Eyewitness Reports on UAP Events, Part 2 (pp. 46–62)

In the second part of his presentation, Jocken Ickinger deals with questions such as repeated interviews with witnesses, interviews with children or older persons, and sightings by groups of people, and gives on overview of the relevant material from scientific publications. While memories and recall are generally better than often assumed, strict procedures must be met not to contaminate recall and to avoid recall errors and influence on witnesses. Ickinger lists 15 main sins of false interviews. An appendix details self-administered interviews which can be used by UFO groups.

Brief Notes (pp. 63–64)

Aliens.gov and UFO-ETF – The US-Government has secured several internet web addresses with “alien” in them, although as yet there is not content, Speculations are hot. Also, Tuttle Capital offers UFO ETFs which invest in companies who use re-engineered alien technology, something which as not yet been proven and which should be regarded with suspicion.

Nike Pope Died – On 6 April 2026, Nick Pope, former holder oft he British UFO desk, died after a severe illness. He was a well-known media personality and broke UFO research to the mainstream.
