

UFO observations (pp. 162-167)

This issue again features two photographic cases. A saucer shaped, red shape on an old analogue photo taken at Witten in June 2010 proved to be, under the microscope, only a retouched scratch on the negative. A picture taken in the night of 10 December 2011 over Büdingen-Lohrbach was confirmed, by calculating the flight path, and checking the time, to be a plane approaching Frankfurt Airport.
