

UFO-OBSERVATIONS (pp. 2–9)

On 19 November 2014, a man took three colour photographs taken with an exposure time of 30 seconds each at night time at Zürich (Switzerland), on which he later found several faint traces of light which he assumed came from an unidentified flying object. The witness thought the object had appeared at a great distance, photo enhancement, however, showed that one of the light traces overlapped a crane boom that stood in a distance of 446 m only, and between the crane and the witness was a sporting ground. Flight path, size, and behaviour of the object, therefore, are consistent with that of a private drone.

THREE TIMES THE SAME UFO? (pp. 9–11)

On 29 August 1967, an egg-shaped UFO with an open top was seen landing at Cussac in France. Tiny humanoids stood around it, then rose into the air and dived into the craft, head first. The same story was reported on 20 December 1970 at Itaperuna, Brazil, and then, again, (as recollection in 1983) on 5 May 1935 at Aznalcázar in Spain. The author discussed this curious triple case, which might appear to prove that real alien craft do in fact exist. But perhaps one report just copied an earlier one? Or we have so many reports now that chance lets us expect even such detailed coincidences?
