

UFO OBSERVATION (pp. 162–164)

At 10:30 a.m. on 9 March 2008, a man observed a grey oval craft over Eisenach which had green and red position lights, moved steadily, stood still for a few seconds, rotated on its axis and then moved away. Although the observation fits neither helicopter nor drone or blimp perfectly, the GEP still feels that a conventional aircraft is the most likely explanation.

**FLYING SAUCERS IN GERMAN PRESS REPORTS
1950 (pp. 165–188)**

The author summarises the content of more than 80 newspaper clippings on what was then still called “flying saucers” and “flying cigars” that were published in Germany in 1950 – ranging from sighting reports from the US, Spain, England, but also Germany, to news stories about American UFO research and alleged German secret weapons from the war. In an analysis, he points out that UFO stories were becoming more widely reported in Germany, that many hoaxes were committed, and that the fake history of Nazi UFOs first turned up in this year.
